HELPFUL HINTS

Use the vocabulary of lighting terms to describe each image. Here are some things to think about when describing the light in each image.

If you don't know what these terms mean, don't worry, you will by the end of the class. Do your best and we'll review this again later.

Try to include details about:

- Quality of light: Hard/Soft
- Direction of the light
- Specular highlights
- Contrast
- Catchlights
- Shape of the light modifier(s)
- Shadow transitions
- What modifiers were used to create the image?
- How far is the light from the subject (inverse square law)?
- How far is the subject from the background?
- What do the reflections tell us about the angle of incidence?
- If you wanted to recreate this image, how would you do it? How would you set up your lights? Which modifiers would you use?
